

# Local Rules for 2017

#### 1. Out of Bounds:

(a) outside the perimeter of the course

(b) in line with or outside the white stakes to the right of the 13th & 15th holes (c) in line with or outside the white stakes to the left of the 18<sup>th</sup> except when playing the 9<sup>th</sup> hole.

#### 2. Water Hazards:

(a) yellow posts indicate Water Hazards - relief, with a penalty of one shot, may be taken as per Rule 26-1 a or b.

(b) red posts indicate a Lateral Water Hazard - relief, with a penalty of one shot, may be taken as per Rule 26-1 a, b or c.

3. Practice Putting Green: a ball coming to rest here must be lifted and dropped, without penalty, in the drop zone provided.

#### 4. Flower/Shrub Beds:

(a) to the left of the 1st tee box (b) between 9<sup>th</sup> green and ladies 8<sup>th</sup> tee box (c) WGC bed at the 10<sup>th</sup> tee box are all deemed ground under repair and Relief without penalty must be taken as per Rule 25-1.

5. Immovable obstructions:

(a) the well to the right of 15<sup>th</sup> fairway (b) all sprinkler heads (c) retaining walls on 2<sup>nd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> tee boxes (d) all stoned paths and sleepers Relief without penalty in accordance with Rule 24-2 Furthermore to this, yellow and red hazard stakes are placed inside the sleepers along the river at the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> and inside the stoned wall of the 18<sup>th</sup> pond (greenside). Therefore these sleepers on 8 and 9 and the stoned wall on 18 are deemed immovable obstructions outside of the hazard.

6. Staked trees: Relief, without penalty, must be taken from all staked or stayed trees in accordance with Rule 24-2b.

Stones in bunkers: may be removed in accordance with Rule 24-1 (movable obstruction) relief without penalty provided the ball does not move in the process.

8. Distance measuring devices: for all play on this course, a player can obtain distance information by using a device which measures distance only – Rule 14-3 applies.

9. Accidental Movement of a Ball on a Putting Green:

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment.

The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1

This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental.

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced."

Please remember to always repair pitch marks, rake bunkers, replace divots & avoid slow play
