- On Tuesday, players should play in the normal draw times: 8.30am and so on. There will be a continuous draw after the 1pm draw on Tuesdays.
- Any Member with a Full Handicap can mark your card and any Lady Member with a Full Handicap can play.

Singles Competition:

- Register your name and pay the £1.50 entry fee in the Pro Shop before commencing your round.
- Singles Stableford Competition over the Front 9 Holes.
- Players may mark as many cards as they like in the week but must pay £1.50 each time as above.
- Weekly section prizes for the winners and runners up.
- Winners of each Section are deducted 2 points and runners up 1 point from the following week onwards this will be for the singles competition only.

Additional Notes:

- The competitions will run for 5 weeks.
- If bad weather intervenes in any week and there is less than a 60% return in the team event, the deadline for both the team and singles competition will be extended by one week.
- The draw for teams will take place on Wednesday 17th January. Teams will be displayed in the ladies locker room. Information on the number of scores to count and team prizes will be displayed also.
- You can mark a card for both the team event and the singles competition simultaneously you must write "Team & Singles" on your scorecard before returning.
- Similarly, when you are marking for the team only you must write "Team" on the scorecard and when you are marking for the singles competition only you must put "Singles" on the scorecard.
- Players who don't wish to enter the team event can still play in the singles competitions as above.
- Scorecards are returned to the normal location in the ladies locker room.
