A ROUND TO REMEMBER FOR HUGHES

Last Wednesday I had the pleasure to play with and mark the card of the very talented young John Hughes who, playing off a handicap of 7, treated our two partners and me to an exhibition of how golf should be played.

With 3 birdies and an eagle, when he holed his 2nd at the 8th, on the front 9, he looked unstoppable with 24 points in the annual Sam Allen Memorial, kindly sponsored this year by Gordon Allen. A string of pars with just one bogey and another birdie on the index 2 13th amassed 45 points for him, and he needed them all with Gerry Durkin [10] breathing down his neck, scoring a total of 44. Great golf from these two last Wednesday. Gerry's score also included 4 birdies, at 2, 4, 11 and 13. Almost unbelievably both players carded a no score hole.

So the middle section prize goes to Gerry Durkin with Hughes winning overall. The high section winner with 42 points was Ultain Cunningham who now receives a 2-shot cut to 25. It was a good score after a double bogey start at the 1st and he also carded one no-score hole. Kerry McVeigh [9] took the low section with 40 points and the gross was won again by the club's star player, Colm Campbell Jnr with 38 points, 5 birdies and no bogeys for a great 5-under par round.

KEENAN ON TOP ON SPONSORS' DAY

The annual Sponsors' Day competition, run in appreciation of the sponsors' contribution towards the club, was won by Michael Keenan [11] with 41 stableford points. With the tees right at the back and some difficult pin positions, it was a well-deserved win after a very steady round. Russell's score was remarkable in that he started with 3 double bogeys and had only 3 points after the first 3 holes. Nine 3 pointers more than made up for this and he finished with 40 points to come 2nd after countback ahead of Jim Somerville[8] who played some great well-controlled shots to turn at 1 over par. Just 3 over on the back 9 ensured his 3rd place.

Stephen Kearney [11], with birdies at 2 and 12 came in 4th with 39 points after countback placed him in front of J Reilly, J Carville and P Reavey.

Colm Campbell Jnr [-3] completed his double for the week, winning the gross prize again with 36 points.

DALY COMES TOP







Winter League Rules

Qualifying

All players will play as individuals for 5 weeks. After 5 weeks the top 40 players will qualify and be allocated to 10 teams of 4. The 10 teams will then compete for a further two weeks for the Winter League hampers. Best 3 scores after 5 weeks determines the qualifying score. Ties will be broken on normal count back procedures based on the third qualifying card.

In addition all competitors will compete for weekly prizes for all of the seven weeks, whether or not they have qualified for a team. The prizes will be in two handicap sections – plus to 15 and 16 to max. A player may win only one weekly prize.

Teams

The team winners will be determined by adding the Team score for each of the 2 weeks. The Team score will be the best 3 scores each week. If teams are tied after 2 weeks ties will be broken on normal count back procedures based on the third best card in week 2.

When you can play

The League will run from Saturday to Friday and you can play at any time during the week – first week commencing 17th Oct. A player who cannot mark a card for whatever reason in the appropriate week will be given a week's latitude, up until the qualifying date is reached. Late cards will not count for weekly prizes.

After qualifying a player who cannot mark a card for whatever reason in week 1 will be allowed to mark 2 cards in week 2.

Bad weather

If bad weather intervenes in any week and there is less than a 60% return the deadline will be extended by one week.

If a situation arises which is not covered in these rules it will be determined on the basis of equity by the Match and Handicap Committee.


